PrestoCast turns a voice note into a podcast in seconds

The new platform lets you create and publish a podcast by sending a simple audio message from WhatsApp, Telegram, or your browser — no technical skills required.

Creating a podcast has always meant learning tools, setting up an RSS feed, editing audio, and figuring out distribution platforms. PrestoCast was built to eliminate all that complexity.

The new platform lets you publish podcast episodes by sending a simple voice message through WhatsApp or Telegram. To try it, just send a voice note to PrestoCast's WhatsApp number: +34 684 75 75 51. Within seconds, that audio is automatically transformed into an episode with an RSS feed, automatic transcription, and its own web page ready to share.

The platform is compatible from day one with major listening platforms, including Apple Podcasts, Spotify, and any RSS-compatible podcatcher.

In addition to sending audio via messaging apps, PrestoCast also offers a web interface at prestocast.com where you can record directly from your browser, manage episodes, and check download statistics.

The platform also includes features designed for audience interaction: listeners can follow creators, save episodes, and leave comments — even via voice notes that are automatically transcribed.

PrestoCast is now available at prestocast.com and is free to use.

PrestoCast is a platform created in Spain that radically simplifies the podcast creation process. Its goal is to remove technical barriers so anyone can publish podcast content using only their voice.
